

### Organization Overview

For more than 90 years, VisionCorps has been helping restore autonomy and independence to the lives of Pennsylvania residents who are blind or vision impaired. From education and prevention, to rehabilitation and employment, we take a comprehensive approach to services. VisionCorps currently has a presence in Lancaster, Lebanon, Berks, Chester, Cumberland and Philadelphia counties.

70% of working-age Americans who are blind are not employed, despite being dedicated, highly skilled and educated individuals. So, many years ago, we formed the VisionCorps Enterprise Group to provide employment opportunities for people who are blind or vision impaired.

VisionCorps Enterprise Group provides its partners with access to federal contracting opportunities through the federal government's AbilityOne Program, the largest source of employment for people who are blind or have significant disabilities. To secure and maintain government contracts through the AbilityOne® Program, at least 75% of VisionCorps' direct labor must be performed by people who are blind.

### The AbilityOne Program

The AbilityOne Program is among the nation's largest providers of jobs for people who are blind or have significant disabilities. Today, the AbilityOne Program provides employment opportunities to more than 45,000 people who are blind or have significant disabilities, including approximately 3,000 veterans. The AbilityOne Program uses the purchasing power of the federal government to buy products and services from participating, community-based nonprofit agencies nationwide, dedicated to training and providing rewarding careers to individuals who are blind or have significant disabilities. Through the AbilityOne Program, people who are blind or have significant disabilities enjoy full participation in their community and can leverage their newly learned skills into other public and private sector jobs.

The AbilityOne Program is authorized by the Javits-Wagner-O'Day Act, the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), and the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR).

## Past Performance

- **U.S. Naval Supply System Command (NAVSUP):** VisionCorps manages comprehensive Contract Closeout Support Services for Field Contracting Offices in Jacksonville, FL, Mechanicsburg, PA, Norfolk, VA, Pearl Harbor, HI, Philadelphia, PA and Puget Sound, WA.
- **Defense Contract Management Agency:** We ensured a 100% efficiency rate utilizing multiple contract writing and storage systems such as Procurement Desktop Defense (PD2), Paperless Contract Filing (PCF) system and several financial payment tracking systems such as Mechanization of Contract Administration Services (MOCAS), Electronic Document Access (EDA) and Invoicing, Receipt, Acceptance and Property Transfer (formerly Wide Area Work Flow).
- **U.S. Naval Supply System Command (NAVSUP):** Our Staff processes modifications to de-obligate funds and completes Contract Action Reports (CARs) in the Federal Procurement Data System - Next Generation (FPDS-NG) system. These actions include closing Firm Fixed Priced (FFP), Cost Plus Fixed Fee (CPFF) and Time and Materials (T&M) contracts.
- **Defense Contract Management Agency, Army Contracting Command – New Jersey and MEDCOM – Fort Gordon:** Our team assists Contracting Officers and Contracting Officer Representatives by performing contract closeout services for over 14,000 contracts. We also de-obligated over \$2.7M for these agencies, with an efficiency rate of 99% over a 5 year period.
- **U.S. Naval Supply System Command (NAVSUP):** Our Experts have closed over 26,000 contracts, completing more than 21,000 Contract Action Reports and de-obligated over \$13M, while performing comprehensive contract support services.
